The tour is overseen by the Call the Midwife producers and features a chance to see props, sets, and costumes.

This is a 90 minute **walking all-weather event** over some uneven ground, so appropriate clothing and footwear are essential.

The Historic Dockyard is well signed. Car Parking is free. (See booking form).

It is also possible to travel by train to Chatham Station, then taking a bus or taxi to the Historic Dockyard.

On arrival at 11.00 we will gather in the restaurant next to reception for a welcome coffee before setting off on our tour.

Your tour ticket gives all day access to the many other interesting exhibits in the Dockyard.

It is also possible for your spouse/partner to join you without doing the tour. They can enjoy a day exploring the many splendid exhibits in the Historic Dockyard and then meet you afterwards.

No group lunch will be arranged however there are several catering facilities in the Dockyard or you are welcome to bring a picnic. This will give you the opportunity to spend more time exploring the site at your own pace after the tour.

Given sufficient interest, a tour of the Ropery, one of only 4 remaining original Royal Naval ropeyards still in operation, can be arranged at 3pm. This is a fascinating experience.
